

#### Kia Ora Parents and Whānau,

On Saturday the 23rd of November (saver date Sunday the 24th of November) we will be running a Colour Run Carnival fundraiser at our school from 11:30 - 3:00 pm. This event will replace our Guy Fawkes fundraiser this year due to the work being completed at Pt Erin Park. There will be many exciting carnival stalls on offer on the day including delicious food, our annual jolly jars, amazing raffles, clothing stalls and of course the Colour Run. **Entry into this event is free**, however if you would like to take part in the Colour Run there is a registration fee. Registrations can still be purchased via Kindo or at our school office. (Please note that any registrations purchased from now up until the event will not include a Colour Run t-shirt).

THIS EVENT IS STRICTLY ALCOHOL FREE & IS A CASH ONLY EVENT. There will be 2 effpos machines at the event where you can get cash out, however we strongly recommend bringing cash for all of the stalls.

## How can you help? Before the event

#### Classroom Stalls - Sign Up

This event is one of our biggest school fundraisers for the year. Every year, each classroom is allocated a stall to run on the evening. Over the next couple of days you will receive an email/Whatsapp message from your child's classroom parent liaison inviting you to sign up through a roster system. There will be a selection of 1 hour shifts available to opt into. If you are able to give up an hour of your time on the day to help at your classroom stall it would be much appreciated.

#### Jolly Jars

A child favourite! For those new to our school this year, your child will be given an eco-friendly (recycled plastic) jar to bring home. Alternatively you can use your own jar from home. The aim is to decorate the jar and fill it with treats. We call this a "Jolly Jar" Your child then brings their Jolly Jar back into school and hands it over to their classroom teacher. These Jolly Jars are a little treat that a child can purchase with their own pocket money at the event. The best judged Jolly Jar from each syndicate will be recognised at school. A great project to complete over the long weekend coming up.

#### Jolly Jar Specifications

Students can decorate inside and/or outside the jar. Make it eye-catching! However, the rule again this year is that the decorated jar is not to be any larger than approx. 20cm tall or 15cm wide/deep (any jars larger than this will not be judged.) The best jolly jar from each syndicate wins a pizza lunch for the creator & 3 friends!

All Jolly Jars need to be returned to your child's classroom teacher by Monday 18th November to be in to win!
