

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia Ora Whānau,

Wow, we are already more than halfway through the term! The next few weeks will be incredibly busy, starting with our Three-Way Learning Conversations next week. Today was the final day to book an interview with your child's teacher. These conversations are a valuable opportunity for students, parents, and teachers to connect and reflect on progress.

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

Next week, I will be meeting with the Director of Education to discuss reporting clarity for schools. All schools are navigating the same challenges, and as a proactive school, we have developed a reporting format that clearly shows how our children are tracking alongside the updated NZ curriculum. We are still waiting on the government and the Ministry of Education to provide guidance and support regarding reporting so hopefully we will gain more clarity from this meeting.

NZ MATHS AND ENGLISH CURRICULUM

With the changes to the NZ Maths and English curriculum, we expect to see a drop in student achievement data. This is simply because the goalposts have shifted. For example, a current Year 3 child is now being taught at a level that was previously a year ahead. These adjustments will take time to settle, and we will continue to support our students through the transition.

INNER CITY CRICKET TOURNAMENT

Last week, we sent two Year 5 & 6 teams to the Inner City Cricket Tournament. Both teams performed exceptionally well, and I was incredibly impressed with their sportsmanship. Our students showed fantastic encouragement and support for each other, even when they weren't winning. A huge thank you to Mr Bergin for organising both teams.

THE TASTE OF PONSONBY FUNDRAISER

We are also in the midst of planning our first major fundraiser, The Taste of Ponsonby, which will take place next term. We are currently seeking auction items such as vouchers, experiences, and sports memorabilia (e.g., signed equipment). All funds raised will go towards upgrading the Puriri playground to create a fantastic new space for our students.

Here is our finished waka and treaty.










We have been bringing in treasures which tell stories about our families. We are going to use these for our visual pepeha.



Help us fill shoebox-sized containers with small but meaningful gifts!




Bring joy to a Child at Starship Children's Hospital in Auckland!
